Also, while writing diagnosis described under main titles, begin with the main title (in abbreviation or otherwise) eg (i) STR, Bursitis shoulder (ii) JIA, polyarticular (iii) SR, upper back (iv) M & N, diabetes (v) INV, ANA. In case of multiple diagnosis, give each diagnosis a separate serial number, beginning with the most important current diagnosis first.
